(a) The clerk of a court who is required to enter information into an execution 8 docket under the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure or other law may 9 enter and maintain the information in an electronic format that 10 allows the information to be retrieved on the same basis as 11 information would be retrieved manually using an index or 12 cross-index to the docket that is otherwise required by law. 13 14 (b) Notwithstanding Section 22.004, Government Code, the supreme court may not amend or adopt rules in conflict with this 15 16 section. SECTION 2. Section 34.03(c), Tax Code, is amended to read as 17 follows: 18 (c) The clerk shall note on the execution docket in each 19 20 case the amount of the excess proceeds, the date they were received, 21 the date they were transmitted to the taxing units and participating in the sale. Any local government record data may be 22 23 stored electronically in addition to or instead of source documents 24 in paper or other media.
