5	SECTION 1. Section 1202.155, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
7	(c) Notwithstanding Subsections (a) and (b), the commission
8	by rule may adopt another method of indicating that the designs,
9	plans, and specifications of industrialized housing and buildings
10	satisfy the requirements of Subsection (a)(1) and are approved in
11	accordance with Subsection (a)(2) if the study conducted under
12	Section 1202.1551 recommends the method.
13	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 1202, Occupations Code, is
14	amended by adding Section 1202.1551 to read as follows:
15	Sec. 1202.1551. STUDY CONCERNING APPROVAL OF DESIGNS,
16	PLANS, AND SPECIFICATIONS. (a) The council shall conduct a study
17	<u>to:</u>
18	(1) evaluate the current method of indicating approval
19	of designs, plans, and specifications of industrialized housing and
20	buildings under Sections 1202.155(a) and (b); and
21	(2) identify and evaluate methods of indicating
22	approval of designs, plans, and specifications of industrialized
23	housing and buildings that are alternatives to the method described
24	by Subdivision (1).

No. 892 (b) The study may recommend for adoption by the commission 1 an alternative method identified under Subsection (a)(2) if the 2 3 council determines that the method would: 4 (1) ensure that the designs, plans, and specifications 5 of industrialized housing and buildings: 6 (A) meet or exceed the code standards and 7 requirements under council interpretations and instructions; and 8 (B) are approved by the department or an approved design review agency; and 9 (2) be more efficient and cost-effective for the 10 department or approved design review agencies. 11 12 (c) This section expires September 1, 2014. SECTION 3. Section 1202.252(a), Occupations 13 Code, is 14 amended to read as follows: 15 (a) A municipality that regulates the on-site construction or installation of industrialized housing and buildings may: 16 17 (1) require and review, for compliance with mandatory codes, building complete set of designs, plans, 18 а and 19 specifications approved by the council [bearing the council's stamp of approval] for each installation of industrialized housing or 20 buildings in the municipality; 21 require that all applicable local permits and 22 (2) 23 licenses be obtained before construction begins on a building site; 24 (3) require, in accordance with commission rules, that 25 all modules or modular components bear an approved decal or 26 insignia indicating inspection by the department; and 27 (4) establish procedures for the inspection of:

1 (A) the erection and installation of 2 industrialized housing or buildings to be located in the 3 municipality, to ensure compliance with mandatory building codes 4 and commission rules; and

5 (B) all foundation and other on-site 6 construction, to ensure compliance with approved designs, plans, 7 and specifications.

8 SECTION 4. Not later than September 1, 2012, the Texas 9 Industrialized Building Code Council shall complete the study 10 required by Section 1202.1551, Occupations Code, as added by this 11 Act.

12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
