(a) A person is eligible for early voting by mail as provided by this chapter if: 8 9 (1) the person is qualified to vote in this state or, if not registered to vote in this state, would be qualified if 10 registered; and 11 12 (2) the person is: 13 (A) a member of the armed forces of the United 14 States, or the spouse or a dependent of a member; 15 (B) a member of the merchant marine of the United 16 States, or the spouse or a dependent of a member; or (C) domiciled in this state but temporarily 17 living outside the territorial limits of the United States and the 18 District of Columbia. 19 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) and Chapter 114, 20 а person who indicates on a federal postcard application that the 21 person is a United States citizen residing outside the United 22 23 States indefinitely is entitled to vote a full ballot as provided by this chapter if the person is otherwise eligible to vote under this 24

1 <u>chapter and is a registered voter at the address contained on the</u> 2 <u>application.</u>

3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a 4 federal postcard application that requests a ballot for an election 5 that is held on or after the effective date of this Act.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
