- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 76.020, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 76.020. OYSTER SHELL RECOVERY AND REPLACEMENT PROGRAM.
- 8 (a) The commission by proclamation may establish and conduct a
- 9 program to require the recovery of oyster shell or other suitable
- 10 cultch material from, and replacement of oyster shell in, the
- 11 coastal waters of the state to maintain or enhance public oyster
- 12 reefs.
- 13 (b) The department may accept grants and donations of money
- 14 or materials from private or public sources to be applied to the
- 15 oyster shell recovery and replacement program.
- 16 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 76, Parks and Wildlife
- 17 Code, is amended by adding Section 76.021 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 76.021. OYSTER SHELL RECOVERY AND REPLACEMENT PROGRAM
- 19 ACCOUNT; FEE. (a) The oyster shell recovery and replacement
- 20 program account is a separate account in the game, fish, and water
- 21 safety account. The account consists of money deposited to the
- 22 account under this section. The account is exempt from the
- 23 <u>application of Section 403.095, Government Code.</u>
- 24 (b) The department shall collect a fee of 20 cents or an

- 1 amount set by the commission, whichever is greater, from a licensed
- 2 commercial oyster fisherman for each box of oysters harvested by
- 3 the fisherman from the water of this state.
- 4 (c) The commission by rule shall adopt policies and
- 5 procedures for the issuance of oyster shell recovery tags or other
- 6 means to collect the fee imposed by this section. A tag required by
- 7 this section must:
- 8 <u>(1) be affixed to the outside of each box of oysters at</u>
- 9 the time of harvest, in the location of harvest;
- 10 (2) contain information required by the Department of
- 11 State Health Services under the National Shellfish Sanitation
- 12 Program; and
- 13 (3) remain affixed during transportation of the
- 14 oysters to a dealer.
- 15 (d) The department shall deposit to the credit of the oyster
- 16 shell recovery and replacement program account all revenue, less
- 17 <u>allowable costs, from the following sources:</u>
- 18 (1) all fees collected under Subsection (b); and
- 19 (2) grants and donations received under Section
- 20 76.020.
- (e) Money in the oyster shell recovery and replacement
- 22 program account may be appropriated only for the recovery and
- 23 enhancement of public oyster reefs under Section 76.020.
- 24 <u>(f) The department shall consult with members of the oyster</u>
- 25 industry regarding the management of oyster beds in this state.
- SECTION 3. Section 76.115, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 27 amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsections (d), (e),

- 1 and (f) to read as follows:
- 2 (c) Before closing any area, the <u>commission</u> [commissioner]
- 3 shall [post notices of the closing in fish and oyster houses in two
- 4 towns nearest the area to be closed and shall] publish notice in a
- 5 daily newspaper of general circulation in the area to be closed.
- 6 The notice [notices] shall be [posted and] published at least three
- 7 days before the effective date of the closing.
- 8 (d) Areas closed under this section must reopen by the
- 9 beginning of the next public oyster season unless sound biological
- 10 data indicates that the need for closure still exists.
- 11 <u>(e) The commission by rule may establish procedures and</u>
- 12 <u>criteria for closing areas under Subsection (a).</u>
- (f) The commission may delegate to the director the duties
- 14 and responsibilities under this section.
- 15 SECTION 4. Not later than January 1, 2012, the Parks and
- 16 Wildlife Commission shall adopt rules:
- 17 (1) for the recovery of oyster shells in accordance
- 18 with this Act; and
- 19 (2) necessary for the implementation of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
