are undergoing comprehensive reform, as determined by the board of 1 2 trustees of the district; and 3 (D) a majority of the students at the campus or at 4 each of the multiple campuses are educationally disadvantaged. 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
