## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- relating to energy efficiency market emission reduction credit 2
- programs established by emission reduction credit organizations. 3
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 384.001, Health and Safety Code, 5
- amended by adding Subdivision (2-a) to read as follows: 6
- 7 (2-a) "Laboratory" means the Energy Systems Laboratory
- at the Texas Engineering Experiment Station of The Texas A&M 8
- 9 University System.
- SECTION 2. Section 384.002, Health and Safety Code, 10
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 384.002. PURPOSE. (a) The purpose of an area emission
- reduction credit organization shall be to promote the coexistence 13
- 14 of the improvement of air quality and economic development within
- the region through the acquisition and distribution of emission 15
- reduction credits. Its activities may include the use of emission 16
- reduction credits to help meet federal reasonable further progress 17
- requirements as well as using emission reduction credits to 18
- facilitate the issuance of permits. 19
- 20 (b) An organization may establish an energy efficiency
- 21 market emission reduction credit program through which a utility,
- municipal utility, electric cooperative, state or local 22
- 23 government, or energy service company that has a program of energy
- efficiency measures established in a nonattainment or near 24

- 1 nonattainment area may register savings from that entity's energy
- 2 efficiency measures as emission reduction credits and sell or trade
- 3 the credits in an effort to reduce emissions of air pollutants in
- 4 urban areas of this state. Emission reduction credits gained
- 5 through energy efficiency measures must be certified by the
- 6 laboratory as having achieved the actual emission reduction.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 384.014, Health and Safety Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 384.014. ANNUAL REPORT. By March 1 of each year each
- 10 area organization shall file with the commission, the laboratory,
- 11 and the regional council of governments an annual report for the
- 12 preceding calendar year. The annual report shall contain:
- 13 (1) a financial accounting;
- 14 (2)  $[\tau]$  an accounting of emission reduction credits;  $[\tau]$
- 15 and
- 16 (3) a listing of all emission reduction credit
- 17 transactions entered into by the organization, including any
- 18 transactions related to the creation of an energy efficiency market
- 19 emission reduction credit program.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
