- CONVICTIONS: LAW ENFORCEMENT FEE. (a) A person convicted of an 9

- Safety Code, shall pay \$100 on conviction of the offense. 11

- under Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code, shall pay \$200 on 13

- (c) Costs imposed under this article are imposed without 15
- regard to whether the defendant is placed on community supervision 16
- after being convicted of the offense or receives deferred 17
- disposition or deferred adjudication for the offense. 18
- (d) The officer collecting the costs under this article 19
- shall keep separate records of the money collected and shall pay the 20

- 16 OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE. A person convicted of an offense under
- 17 Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code, shall pay the following under
- 18 Article 102.0179, Code of Criminal Procedure, in addition to all
- 19 other costs, to be used for law enforcement purposes:
- 20 (1) court cost on conviction of a misdemeanor
- 21 offense . . \$100; and
- 22 (2) court cost on conviction of a felony offense
- 23 . . . \$200.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 25 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 26 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 27 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the

- 1 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 2 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 3 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
