## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to fair treatment of all providers of instructional

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 51.949 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 51.949. FAIR TREATMENT OF PROVIDERS OF INSTRUCTIONAL
9	MATERIALS. (a) In this section:
10	(1) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
11	assigned by Section 61.003.

- 12 (2) "Instructional materials" means any printed or
- 13 computer-generated educational material, including textbooks, or
- 14 any equipment or supplies that a student is required or recommended
- 15 to use in connection with a course at an institution of higher
- 16 education.
- 17 (b) An institution of higher education may not grant
- 18 preference to any provider of textbooks or other instructional
- 19 materials in conducting activities of the institution:
- 20 (1) during student orientation or registration; or
- 21 (2) as part of any program for repurchasing
- 22 instructional materials from students.
- SECTION 2. Section 51.949, Education Code, as added by this
- 24 Act, applies only to a semester or term that begins on or after the

- 1 effective date of this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
