## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of the Finance Commission of Texas.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 11.102, Finance Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) One member of the finance commission must be a banking
- 7 executive, one member of the finance commission must be a savings
- 8 executive, one member of the finance commission must be a consumer
- 9 credit executive, and one member of the finance commission must be a
- 10 residential mortgage loan originator licensed under Chapter 156 or
- 11 157 [<del>broker</del>].
- 12 SECTION 2. Subdivision (4), Subsection (e), Section 11.102,
- 13 Finance Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 (4) "Residential mortgage loan originator" ["Mortgage
- 15 broker"] means a person who:
- 16 (A) has had five years' or more experience as a
- 17 <u>residential</u> mortgage <u>loan originator</u> [broker], as defined by
- 18 Section 180.002 [156.002], during the seven-year period preceding
- 19 the person's appointment; and
- 20 (B) is a <u>residential</u> mortgage <u>loan originator</u>
- 21 [broker], as defined by Section 180.002 [156.002].
- 22 SECTION 3. (a) A member of the Finance Commission of Texas
- 23 who is a mortgage broker and who is serving on the effective date of
- 24 this Act continues to serve until the expiration of the term for

- 1 which the member was appointed.
- 2 (b) As soon as practicable following the expiration of the
- 3 term of the member described in Subsection (a) of this section or
- 4 following any vacancy in that position that occurs before the
- 5 expiration of the term, the governor shall make an appointment to
- 6 the Finance Commission of Texas to achieve the composition
- 7 prescribed by Section 11.102, Finance Code, as amended by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
