A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to time of day during which prisoners may be discharged or
- 3 released from county jails.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 511, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 511.0098 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 511.0098. DISCHARGE OR RELEASE TIME. (a) The
- 8 commission shall adopt rules establishing the time of day during
- 9 which prisoners, other than prisoners being released on bond, may
- 10 be discharged or released from county jails.
- 11 (b) The rules adopted under Subsection (a) may not allow a
- 12 prisoner, other than a prisoner being admitted to an inpatient
- 13 mental health facility or a state-supported living center for
- 14 court-ordered mental health or mental retardation services or being
- 15 transferred to the custody of another state, a unit of the federal
- 16 government, or a facility operated by or under contract with the
- 17 Texas Department of Criminal Justice, to be discharged or released
- 18 from a county jail after 7 p.m. and before 7 a.m., unless an exigent
- 19 <u>circumstance requires the prisoner's discharge or release after 7</u>
- 20 p.m. and before 7 a.m.
- 21 <u>(c) The rules adopted under Subsection (a) must require that</u>
- 22 the operator of a county jail maintain a record of each prisoner
- 23 <u>discharged or released after 7 p.m. and before 7 a.m. The record</u>
- 24 must include:

- 1 (1) the exigent circumstance that warranted the
- 2 prisoner's discharge or release after 7 p.m. and before 7 a.m.;
- 3 (2) if applicable, the date and time the operator
- 4 received a release order or similar document from a court or other
- 5 <u>authority; and</u>
- 6 (3) the date and time of the prisoner's discharge or
- 7 <u>release.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. The Commission on Jail Standards shall adopt the
- 9 rules required by Section 511.0098, Government Code, as added by
- 10 this Act, not later than January 1, 2012.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
