6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 61.0666 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 61.0666. STUDY REGARDING ESTABLISHMENT OF DENTAL
9	SCHOOL; EL PASO. (a) The board shall conduct a study to examine
10	the need for and feasibility of establishing a dental school in El
11	Paso as a component of the Texas Tech University Health Sciences
12	Center. The board shall consult with the board of regents of the
13	Texas Tech University System in conducting the study.
14	(b) Not later than November 1, 2012, the board shall report
15	the results of the study required by this section to the governor,
16	lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of representatives, and
17	presiding officer of each legislative standing committee with
18	primary jurisdiction over higher education.
19	(c) This section expires January 31, 2013.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
