4	SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 155.051, Occupations

(d) The limitation on examination attempts by an applicant 6 7 under Subsection (a) does not apply to an applicant who [+ [(1) is licensed and in good standing as a physician in 8 9 another state; [(2) has been licensed for at least five years; 10 [(3) does not hold a medical license in the other state 11 that has any restrictions, disciplinary orders, or probation; and 12 [(4) passed all but one part of the examination 13 approved by the board within three attempts and: 14 15  $[(\Lambda)$  passed the remaining part of the examination 16 within one additional attempt; or 17 [(B) passed the remaining part of the examination within six attempts if the applicant: 18 [(i)] is specialty board certified by a 19 20 specialty board that: (1) [(a)] is a member of the American Board of Medical 21 Specialties; or 22 (2) [(b)] is approved by the American Osteopathic 23 24 Association[; and 25 [(ii) has completed in this state additional two years of postgraduate medical training approved by 26 27 the board].
