20	(2) appoint an attorney ad litem to represent the
21	parent if the court determines that the parent is indigent.
22	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
23	to a suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed on or after
24	the effective date of this Act. A suit filed before that date is
