- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 243.0075, Local
- 6 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) An applicant for a license or permit issued under
- 8 Section 243.007 for a location not <u>currently</u> [previously] licensed
- 9 or permitted shall, not later than the 60th day before the date the
- 10 application is filed, prominently post an outdoor sign at the
- 11 location stating that a sexually oriented business is intended to
- 12 be located on the premises and providing the name and business
- 13 address of the applicant.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to an application for a license or permit filed on or after
- 16 September 1, 2011.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
