## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the eligibility of employees convicted of certain

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.0834(o), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (o) A contracting or subcontracting entity may not permit an
- 8 employee to whom Subsection (a) applies to provide services at a
- 9 school if the employee has been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor
- 10 offense that would prevent a person from being employed [obtaining
- 11  $\frac{\text{certification as an educator}}{\text{certification as an educator}}$  under Section  $\frac{22.085(a)}{\text{certification as an educator}}$ .
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 22.0834(o), Education Code, as amended
- 13 by this Act, applies to the provision of services at a public school
- 14 by an employee of a contracting or subcontracting entity without
- 15 regard to whether the contract or subcontract under which the
- 16 person is employed was entered into before, on, or after the
- 17 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
