- 5 SECTION 1. Section 542.056, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (e), (f), and (g) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) If an insurer pays a claim not later than the 15th
- 8 business day after the date the insurer receives all items,
- 9 statements, and forms required by the insurer to secure final proof
- 10 of loss, or not later than the 30th day if the insurer has a
- 11 reasonable basis to believe that the loss that is the subject of the
- 12 claim resulted from arson, the payment of the claim constitutes
- 13 <u>notice of acceptance of the claim and, notwithstanding Subsection</u>
- 14 (a), the insurer is not required to provide any other notice under
- 15 this section.

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- 16 (f) If an insurer makes a partial payment on a claim under
- 17 this section or rejects any portion of a claim, the insurer shall
- 18 include a written notice with the partial payment that states the
- 19 <u>reason for the rejection.</u>
- 20 (g) For purposes of Subsections (e) and (f), payment
- 21 <u>includes an electronic funds transfer to an account identified by</u>
- 22 the claimant.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to a claim filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A claim

- 1 filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- $2\,$  as it existed immediately before that date, and that law is
- 3 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
