A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the transfer of certain vehicle registrations at the 3 time of sale of the vehicle.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 502.451, Transportation Code, is amended 6 by amending Subsections (a), (a-1), and (c) and adding Subsection 7 (a-2) to read as follows:

8 (a) On the sale or transfer of a motor vehicle to a dealer, 9 as defined by Section 503.001, who holds a general distinguishing 10 number issued under Chapter 503, the dealer shall remove each 11 license plate and the registration insignia issued for the motor 12 vehicle. <u>The registration period remaining at the time of sale or</u> 13 <u>transfer expires at the time of sale or transfer.</u>

14 (a-1) <u>On the sale of a used motor vehicle by a dealer, the</u>
15 <u>dealer shall issue to the buyer new registration documents for an</u>
16 <u>entire registration year.</u>

17 <u>(a-2)</u> On a sale or transfer of a motor vehicle to a person 18 that does not hold a general distinguishing number issued under 19 Chapter 503, the seller or transferor may remove each license plate 20 and the registration insignia issued for the motor vehicle.

(c) <u>On a sale or transfer of a motor vehicle in which neither</u> party holds a general distinguishing number issued under Chapter <u>503, the</u> [The] part of the registration period remaining at the time of the sale or transfer shall continue with the vehicle being sold

1 or transferred and does not transfer with the license plates or 2 registration validation insignia. To continue the remainder of the 3 registration period, the purchaser or transferee must file the 4 documents required under Section 520.031.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
