- 5 SECTION 1. Section 502.451, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsections (a), (a-1), and (c) and adding Subsection
- 7 (a-2) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) On the sale or transfer of a motor vehicle to a dealer,
- 9 as defined by Section 503.001, who holds a general distinguishing
- 10 number issued under Chapter 503, the dealer shall remove each
- 11 license plate and the registration insignia issued for the motor
- 12 vehicle. The registration period remaining at the time of sale or
- 13 transfer expires at the time of sale or transfer.
- 14 (a-1) On the sale of a used motor vehicle by a dealer, the
- 15 dealer shall issue to the buyer new registration documents for an
- 16 entire registration year.
- 17 (a-2) On a sale or transfer of a motor vehicle to a person
- 18 that does not hold a general distinguishing number issued under
- 19 Chapter 503, the seller or transferor may remove each license plate
- 20 and the registration insignia issued for the motor vehicle.
- 21 (c) On a sale or transfer of a motor vehicle in which neither
- 22 party holds a general distinguishing number issued under Chapter
- 23 503, the [The] part of the registration period remaining at the time

- 1 or transferred and does not transfer with the license plates or
