A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the student fees for the university center at

- 3 Midwestern State University.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 54.518, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (a) To the extent approved by the students under Subsection
- 9 (b) [of this section], the Board of Regents of Midwestern State
- 10 University is hereby authorized to levy a regular, fixed student
- 11 fee not to exceed, except as authorized under Subsection (d), \$15
- 12 per student for each semester of the long session and not to exceed
- 13 \$7.50 per student for all or part of each term of the summer session
- 14 for the purpose of operating, maintaining, improving, equipping,
- 15 and financing the university center and acquiring or constructing
- 16 additions to the center. The amount of the fee may be changed at any
- 17 time within the limits specified by this subsection in order to
- 18 provide sufficient funds to support the university center. The
- 19 fees authorized in this section supplement any other use or service
- 20 fee authorized by law.
- (b) The decision to levy such a fee, the amount of the
- 22 initial fee, and any increase in the fee within the limits specified
- 23 by Subsection (a) must be approved by a majority vote of those
- 24 students participating in a general election called for that

- 1 purpose.
- 2 (d) The board may increase the amount of the fee for a
- 3 <u>semester or summer session in excess</u> of the applicable amount
- 4 provided by Subsection (a) if the increase is approved by a majority
- 5 vote of those students participating in a general election called
- 6 for that purpose. The increased amount under this subsection may
- 7 not be charged after the fifth academic year in which the increased
- 8 amount is first charged unless, before the end of that academic
- 9 year, the institution has issued bonds payable from the fee, in
- 10 which event the increased amount may not be charged after the
- 11 <u>academic year in which all such bonds</u>, including refunding bonds
- 12 for those bonds, have been fully paid.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to fees imposed for a semester or term that begins on or after the
- 15 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
