- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2210.254, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The department may establish an annual renewal period
- 8 for persons appointed as qualified inspectors.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 2210, Insurance Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 2210.2551 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 2210.2551. EXCLUSIVE ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY; RULES.
- 12 (a) The department has exclusive authority over all matters
- 13 relating to the appointment and oversight of qualified inspectors
- 14 for purposes of this chapter.
- (b) The commissioner by rule shall establish criteria to
- 16 ensure that a person seeking appointment as a qualified inspector
- 17 under this subchapter, including an engineer seeking appointment
- 18 under Section 2210.255, possesses the knowledge, understanding,
- 19 and professional competence to perform windstorm inspections under
- 20 this chapter and to comply with other requirements of this chapter.

Section 2210.256, Insurance Code, is amended by 1 2 adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows: 3 (a-2) In addition to any other action authorized under this section, the commissioner ex parte may enter an emergency cease and 4 5 desist order under Chapter 83 against a qualified inspector, or a person acting as a qualified inspector, if: 6 7 (1) the commissioner believes that: (A) the qualified inspector has: 8 (i) through submitting or failing to submit 9 to the department sealed plans, designs, calculations, or other 10 substantiating information, failed to demonstrate that a structure 11 12 or a portion of a structure subject to inspection meets the requirements of this chapter and department rules; or 13 14 (ii) refused to comply with requirements 15 imposed under this chapter or department rules; or (B) the person acting as a qualified inspector is 16 17 acting without appointment as a qualified inspector under Section 2210.254 or 2210.255; and 18 19 (2) the commissioner determines that the conduct described by Subdivision (1) is fraudulent or hazardous or creates 20 an immediate danger to the public. 21 SECTION 5. Section 83.002, Insurance Code, is amended by 22 23 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
