- 9 comparable sales data described by Subsection (b) only if the
- 10 information, item of information, or comparable sales data relates
- 11 to real property that is located in a county having a population of
- 12 $[\frac{20,000 \text{ or}}{}]$ more than 50,000.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
