1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the exception from required public disclosure of
1-11 certain records of an appraisal district.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subsection (e), Section 552.149, Government
1-14 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-15 (e) This section applies to information described by
1-16 Subsections (a), (c), and (d) and to an item of information or
1-17 comparable sales data described by Subsection (b) only if the
1-18 information, item of information, or comparable sales data relates
1-19 to real property that is located in a county having a population of
1-20 ~~[20,000 or]~~ more than 50,000.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
