| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Chapter 186, Utilities Code, is amended by |
| 6 | adding Section 186.0021 to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 186.0021. WEATHERIZATION AND PREPAREDNESS REPORT. |
| 8 | (a) To ensure reliability of electric service during extreme |
| 9 | weather events, the commission, in consultation with the Electric |
| 10 | Reliability Council of Texas, shall prepare a report on the |
| 11 | weatherization and preparedness of generators within the Electric |
| 12 | Reliability Council of Texas. Subsequent reports shall be |
| 13 | submitted only if significant changes to weatherization have |
| 14 | occurred or are necessary to protect consumers, vital services or |
| 15 | if there have been changes to statute or rule relating to |
| 16 | weatherization requirements. In preparing the report, the |
| 17 | <pre>commission shall:</pre> |
| 18 | (1) review the weatherization plans currently on file |
| 19 | with the commission; |
| 20 | (2) analyze and determine whether such plans are |
| 21 | adequate to ensure reliability of the electric grid for the |
| 22 | upcoming summer or winter; |
| 23 | (3) consider the anticipated weather patterns for the |
| 24 | uncoming summer or winter as forecasted by the National Weather |

- 1 Service or any similar state or national agency; and
- 2 (4) make recommendations as to how weatherization
- 3 procedures can be improved to carry out the policies stated in this
- 4 section.
- 5 (b) In reviewing a weatherization plan described by
- 6 Subsection (a) and to further the policies stated in this chapter,
- 7 the commission, on finding that a weatherization plan on file is
- 8 <u>lacking in sufficient detail to determine its adequacy</u>, shall
- 9 require a generator to file an updated report containing sufficient
- 10 detail.
- 11 <u>(c) The commission shall finalize and publish the report</u>
- 12 described by Subsection (a):
- 13 (1) not later than March 1st of each year for the
- 14 summer weatherization and preparedness report; and
- 15 (2) not later than September 1st of each year for the
- 16 winter weatherization and preparedness report.
- 17 (d) The commission shall adopt rules relating to the
- 18 implementation of the report described by Subsection (a) and any
- 19 other rules necessary to accomplish the purposes of the report.
- 20 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of state law, the
- 21 weatherization plans of generators considered in the publication of
- 22 the report described by Subsection (a) are not confidential or
- 23 otherwise exempt from disclosure under Chapter 552, Government
- 24 Code.
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
