- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 104.103, Utilities Code,
- 5 is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) Instead of publishing newspaper notice, a gas utility
- 7 may provide notice [to the public in an area outside the affected
- 8 municipality or in a municipality with a population of less than
- 9 $\frac{2,500}{}$] by:
- 10 (1) mailing the notice by United States mail, postage
- 11 prepaid, to the billing address of each directly affected customer;
- 12 [or]
- 13 (2) including the notice, in conspicuous form, in the
- 14 bill of each directly affected customer; or
- 15 (3) sending the notice by e-mail to each directly
- 16 affected customer if that address is available to the utility.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to a notice of a proposed utility rate increase provided on or after
- 19 the effective date of this Act. Notice provided before the
- 20 effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
- 21 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 22 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
