S.B. No. 1155

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the appointment of a person with experience and
3 training in public health policy to the board of directors of a
4 regional mobility authority.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 370.251, Transportation Code, is amended
7 by amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (a-2) to read as
8 follows:

9 (a-2) The commissioners courts of each county participating
10 in the authority by agreement, or the governing body of a
11 municipality that created an authority, shall appoint a person with
12 experience and training in public health policy to serve as a
13 nonvoting director. The nonvoting director appointed under this
14 subsection shall provide the board with an assessment of the public
15 health impact of each proposed transportation project of the
16 authority.

17 (h) Each director other than the director described by
18 Subsection (a-2) has equal status and may vote.

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
