A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the sale of fireworks on and before Memorial Day. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 2154.202(g), Occupations 4 Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (g) A retail fireworks permit holder may sell fireworks only 7 to the public, and only during periods: beginning on the 14th day preceding Memorial Day 8 (1)9 and ending at midnight on Memorial Day; (2) beginning June 24 and ending at midnight on July 4; 10 11 (3) [(2)] beginning December 20 and ending at midnight 12 on January 1 of the following year; and 13 (4) [(3)] beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on 14 May 5 if the fireworks are sold at a location that is not more than 100 miles from the Texas-Mexico border and that is in a county in 15 16 which the commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of fireworks during the period. 17 18 SECTION 2. Section 352.051(b)(1), Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 20 (1)The Texas Forest Service in the ordinary course of 21 its activities shall determine whether drought conditions, as defined under Subsection (a)(2), exist on average in any county 22 23 requesting such a determination. The Texas Forest Service shall make available the measurement index guidelines used to determine 24

1 whether drought conditions exist in a particular area. Following 2 any determination that such drought conditions exist, the Texas 3 Forest Service shall notify said county or counties when such 4 drought conditions no longer exist. The Texas Forest Service shall 5 make its services available each day during the <u>Memorial Day</u>, 6 Fourth of July, and December fireworks seasons to respond to the 7 request of any county for a determination whether drought 8 conditions exist on average in the county.

9 SECTION 3. Section 352.051(d), Local Government Code, is 10 amended to read as follows:

11 (d) To facilitate compliance with an order adopted under 12 Subsection (c), the order must be adopted before:

13 (1) April 25 of each year for the Cinco de Mayo 14 fireworks season;

15 (2) May 5 of each year for the Memorial Day fireworks
16 season;

17 (3) [(2)] June 15 of each year for the Fourth of July 18 fireworks season; and

19 <u>(4)</u> [(3)] December 15 of each year for each December 20 fireworks season.

21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
