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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 254, Health and Safety
- 7 Code, as added by Chapter 1273 (H.B. 1357), Acts of the 81st
- 8 Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is amended by adding Section
- 9 254.002 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 254.002. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER; LIMITATION ON
- 11 RULEMAKING AUTHORITY. (a) This chapter may not be construed as
- 12 prohibiting a licensed health care professional from providing in a
- 13 <u>freestanding emergency medical care facility licensed under this</u>
- 14 chapter medical care provided at the time emergency care is
- 15 provided, or public health services, that are within the scope of
- 16 the health care professional's license and that are not required to
- 17 be provided in another facility under other law.
- 18 (b) In adopting rules under Section 254.151(a), the
- 19 <u>executive commissioner may not adopt a rule that conflicts with</u>
- 20 <u>Subsection (a).</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
