- 2 relating to the issuance of identification cards to certain peace
  3 officers and honorably retired peace officers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 614.121(1), Government Code, as added by
- 6 Chapter 938 (H.B. 3613), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular
- 7 Session, 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (1) "Peace [Full-time peace] officer" means a person
- 9 elected, employed, or appointed as a peace officer under Article
- 10 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, or other law[ $\tau$ ] who holds a
- 11 license issued under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code[+
- 12 [(A) works as a peace officer on average at least
- 13 32 hours per week, exclusive of paid vacation; and
- 14 [(B) is compensated by this state or a political
- 15 subdivision of this state at least at the federal minimum wage and
- 16 is entitled to all employee benefits offered to a peace officer by
- 17 the state or political subdivision].
- SECTION 2. Sections 614.122(a) and (c), Government Code, as
- 19 added by Chapter 938 (H.B. 3613), Acts of the 80th Legislature,
- 20 Regular Session, 2007, are amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) The law enforcement agency or other governmental entity
- 22 that appoints or employs a peace officer shall issue an
- 23 identification card to its sworn [full-time or part-time] peace
- 24 officers.

- 1 (c) On the identification card, the law enforcement agency
- 2 or other governmental entity that issues the card shall print:
- 3 (1) "State of Texas" and the state seal; and
- 4 (2) "This identification card certifies that (insert
- 5 name of peace officer) is commissioned by (insert name of law
- 6 enforcement agency or other governmental entity that appoints or
- 7 employs the peace officer) as a sworn peace officer [(insert
- 8 "full-time peace officer" or "part-time peace officer")]."
- 9 SECTION 3. Sections 614.124(a) and (d), Government Code, as
- 10 added by Chapter 938 (H.B. 3613), Acts of the 80th Legislature,
- 11 Regular Session, 2007, are amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a) The law enforcement agency or other governmental entity
- 13 that was the last entity to appoint or employ an honorably retired
- 14 peace officer as a peace officer <u>shall</u> [may] issue an
- 15 identification card to its honorably retired peace officers.
- 16 (d) The head of a law enforcement agency or other
- 17 governmental entity that issued the identification card shall
- 18 recover the identification card on the date the identification card
- 19 expires, unless the identification card is issued without an
- 20 expiration date.
- SECTION 4. Sections 614.125 and 614.127, Government Code,
- 22 as added by Chapter 938 (H.B. 3613), Acts of the 80th Legislature,
- 23 Regular Session, 2007, are amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 614.125. EXPIRATION DATE. (a) An identification card
- 25 issued under this subchapter expires on a date specified by the law
- 26 enforcement agency or other governmental entity issuing the card.
- 27 (b) A law enforcement agency or other governmental entity

- 1 may issue under Section 614.124 an identification card without an
- 2 expiration date to an honorably retired peace officer.
- 3 Sec. 614.127. LOST OR STOLEN CARDS. If an identification
- 4 card issued under this subchapter is lost or stolen, the law
- 5 enforcement agency or other governmental entity issuing the card
- 6 may:
- 7 (1) require a peace officer[ reserve law enforcement
- 8 officer, or honorably retired peace officer to submit an affidavit
- 9 executed by the peace officer[ reserve law enforcement officer,]
- 10 or honorably retired peace officer to the law enforcement agency or
- 11 other governmental entity issuing the card stating that the
- 12 identification card was lost or stolen; and
- 13 (2) issue a duplicate identification card to the peace
- 14 officer[ reserve law enforcement officer ] or honorably retired
- 15 peace officer.
- 16 SECTION 5. (a) The following provisions of the Government
- 17 Code are repealed:
- 18 (1) Sections 614.121(3) and (4), as added by Chapter
- 19 938 (H.B. 3613), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 20 2007; and
- 21 (2) Section 614.123, as added by Chapter 938 (H.B.
- 22 3613), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007.
- (b) Subchapter H, Chapter 614, Government Code, as added by
- 24 Chapter 1187 (H.B. 638), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular
- 25 Session, 2007, is repealed.
- 26 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
