- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 157.263, Family Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) In rendering a money judgment under this section, the
- 9 court may not reduce or modify the amount of child support
- 10 arrearages but, in confirming the amount of arrearages, may allow a
- 11 counterclaim or offset as provided by this title.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 231, Family Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Section 231.124 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 231.124. CHILD SUPPORT ARREARAGES PAYMENT INCENTIVE
- 15 PROGRAM. (a) The Title IV-D agency may establish and administer a
- 16 payment incentive program to promote payment by obligors who are
- 17 delinquent in satisfying child support arrearages assigned to the
- 18 Title IV-D agency under Section 231.104(a).
- (b) A program established under this section must provide to
- 20 <u>a participating obligor a credit for every dollar amount paid by the</u>
- 21 <u>obligor on interest and arrearages balances during each month of</u>
- 22 the obligor's voluntary enrollment in the program. In establishing
- 23 a program under this section, the Title IV-D agency by rule must
- 24 prescribe:

- 1 (1) criteria for a child support obligor's initial
- 2 eligibility to participate in the program;
- 3 (2) the conditions for a child support obligor's
- 4 continued participation in the program;
- 5 (3) procedures for enrollment in the program; and
- 6 (4) the terms of the financial incentives to be
- 7 offered under the program.
- 8 <u>(c) The Title IV-D agency shall provide eligible obligors</u>
- 9 with notice of the program and enrollment instructions.
- 10 SECTION 3. Section 157.262, Family Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 4. Subsection (b-1), Section 157.263, Family Code,
- 12 as added by this Act, applies to a motion for enforcement of child
- 13 support that is pending before a trial court on or filed on or after
- 14 the effective date of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
