A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to persons authorized to access or use electronically
- 3 readable information derived from a driver's license, commercial
- 4 driver's license, or personal identification certificate.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 521.126, Transportation
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (d) The prohibition provided by Subsection (b) does not
- 9 apply to a person who accesses, uses, compiles, or maintains a
- 10 database of the information for a law enforcement or governmental
- 11 purpose, including:
- 12 (1) an officer or employee of the department carrying
- 13 out law enforcement or government purposes;
- 14 (2) a peace officer, as defined by Article 2.12, Code
- 15 of Criminal Procedure, acting in the officer's official capacity;
- 16 (3) a license deputy, as defined by Section 12.702,
- 17 Parks and Wildlife Code, issuing a license, stamp, tag, permit, or
- 18 other similar item through use of a point-of-sale system under
- 19 Section 12.703, Parks and Wildlife Code;
- 20 (4) a person acting as authorized by Section 109.61,
- 21 Alcoholic Beverage Code;
- 22 (5) a person establishing the identity of a voter
- 23 under Chapter 63, Election Code;
- 24 (6) a person acting as authorized by Section 161.0825,

- 1 Health and Safety Code; [or]
- 2 (7) a person screening an individual who will work
- 3 with or have access to children if the person is an employee or an
- 4 agent of an employee of a public school district or an organization
- 5 exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3), Internal
- 6 Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that sponsors a program for youth;
- 7 <u>or</u>
- 8 (8) a person who possesses a certificate issued by the
- 9 <u>department under Section 724.016 or who is otherwise authorized to</u>
- 10 take or analyze a breath specimen under Chapter 724 or other law.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
