1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the board of directors of the Greater East End
1-11 Management District.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 3807.052,
1-14 Special District Local Laws Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-15 (a) The mayor and members of the governing body of the City
1-16 of Houston shall appoint directors from persons recommended by:

1-17 (1) the board; and

1-18 (2) the state senator and state representative who
1-19 represent the largest area of the district as of April 1, 2010.

1-20 ~~[Notwithstanding Subchapter D, Chapter 375, Local Government Code,~~
1-21 ~~to be qualified to serve as director, a person must be at least 18~~
1-22 ~~years of age and:~~

1-23 ~~[(1) be a resident of the district; or~~

1-24 ~~[(2) have a district business interest.]~~

1-25 (b) Appointments to the board must ensure that [+

1-26 [(1)] at least one-third [60 percent] of the directors
1-27 are residents of the district[+, and

1-28 [(2) each director who does not reside in the district
1-29 has a district business interest].

1-30 SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 3807.052, Special
1-31 District Local Laws Code, is repealed.

1-32 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
1-33 only to a person appointed to the board of directors of the Greater
1-34 East End Management District on or after the effective date of this
1-35 Act.

1-36 (b) The change in law made by this Act does not affect the
1-37 right of a person appointed to the board of directors of the Greater
1-38 East End Management District before the effective date of this Act
1-39 to continue to serve on the board until the person's term expires.

1-40 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-41 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-42 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-43 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
