3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 552.001(a), Occupations Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(a) The Texas State Board of Pharmacy consists of 11 [nine]
7	members appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the
8	senate as follows:
9	(1) six members who are pharmacists; [and]
10	(2) one member who is a pharmacy technician; and
11	(3) four [three] members who represent the public.
12	SECTION 2. Section 552.002, Occupations Code, is amended by
13	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
14	(b-1) A pharmacy technician board member must, at the time
15	of appointment:
16	(1) be a resident of this state;
17	(2) have been registered as a pharmacy technician for
18	the five years preceding appointment;
19	(3) be in good standing to act as a pharmacy technician
20	in this state; and
21	(4) be acting as a pharmacy technician in this state.
22	SECTION 3. Section 552.005(a), Occupations Code, is amended

23 to read as follows:

(a) Members of the board are appointed for staggered

- 1 six-year terms, with either [. The terms of] three or four members'
- 2 terms, as applicable, expiring [members expire] every other year at
- 3 midnight on the last day of the state fiscal year in the last year of
- 4 the member's term.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 552.010(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The board shall meet at least [+
- 8 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ once every four months to transact board
- 9 business[; and
- 10 [(2) twice each year for the examination of
- 11 applicants].
- 12 SECTION 5. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 13 of this Act, the governor shall appoint a pharmacy technician and a
- 14 public member to the Texas State Board of Pharmacy as required by
- 15 this Act. In appointing the members, the governor shall appoint:
- 16 (1) a pharmacy technician to a term expiring August
- 17 31, 2017; and
- 18 (2) a public member to a term expiring August 31, 2015.
- 19 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
