## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to transportation, lodging, and meals offered to and 2 3 accepted by public servants. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 36.07, Penal Code, is amended by adding 5 6 Subsection (b-1) to read as follows: (b-1) Transportation, lodging, and meals described by 7 Subsection (b) are not political contributions as defined by Title 8 9 15, Election Code. 10 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 36.10, Penal Code, is amended to read as follows: 11 Sections 36.08 (Gift to Public Servant) and 36.09 12 (a) (Offering Gift to Public Servant) do not apply to: 13 14 (1) a fee prescribed by law to be received by a public 15 servant or any other benefit to which the public servant is lawfully entitled or for which he gives legitimate consideration in a 16 17 capacity other than as a public servant; (2) a gift or other benefit conferred on account of 18 19 kinship or a personal, professional, or business relationship independent of the official status of the recipient; or 20 21 (3) a benefit to a public servant required to file a 22 statement under Chapter 572, Government Code, or a report under Title 15, Election Code, that is derived from a function in honor or 23 24 appreciation of the recipient if:

No. 1269 1 (A) the benefit and the source of any benefit in 2 excess of \$50 is reported in the statement; and (B) the benefit is used solely to defray the 3 expenses that accrue in the performance of duties or activities in 4 connection with the office which are nonreimbursable by the state 5 or political subdivision; 6 7 (4) a political contribution as defined by Title 15, Election Code; 8 a gift, award, or memento to a member of the 9 (5) 10 legislative or executive branch that is required to be reported under Chapter 305, Government Code; 11 (6) an item with a value of less than \$50, excluding 12 cash or a negotiable instrument as described by Section 3.104, 13 Business & Commerce Code; [<del>or</del>] 14 15 (7) an item issued by a governmental entity that 16 allows the use of property or facilities owned, leased, or operated by the governmental entity; or 17 18 (8) transportation, lodging, and meals described by Section 36.07(b). 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011. 20
