1 AN ACT

2 relating to contributions to the retirement systems for certain

- 3 police officers in certain municipalities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subdivisions (1) and (2), Subsection (a),
- 6 Section 8.01, Chapter 452 (S.B. 738), Acts of the 72nd Legislature,
- 7 Regular Session, 1991 (Article 6243n-1, Vernon's Texas Civil
- 8 Statutes), are amended to read as follows:
- 9 (1) Deposits by the members to the police retirement
- 10 system shall be made at a rate of at least 13 [six] percent of the
- 11 basic hourly earnings of each member. Deposits required to be made
- 12 by members shall be deducted from payroll. On recommendation of the
- 13 board, the Active--Contributory members may by a majority of those
- 14 voting increase the rate of member deposits above  $\underline{13}$  [ $\underline{six}$ ] percent
- 15 to whatever amount the board has recommended. If the deposit rate
- 16 for members has been increased to a rate above 13 [six] percent, the
- 17 rate may be decreased if the board recommends the decrease, the
- 18 board's actuary approves the decrease, and a majority of the
- 19 Active--Contributory members voting on the matter approve the
- 20 decrease.
- 21 (2) The city shall contribute amounts equal to 18
- 22 percent of the basic hourly earnings of each member employed by the
- 23 city for all periods on or before September 30, 2010, subject to
- 24 additional amounts as provided by Subdivision (3) of this

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subsection. The city shall contribute amounts equal to 19 percent 1 2 of the basic hourly earnings of each member employed by the city for all periods after September 30, 2010, and before October 1, 2011, 3 subject to additional amounts as provided by Subdivision (3) of 4 this subsection. The city shall contribute amounts equal to 20 5 percent of the basic hourly earnings of each member employed by the 6 7 city for all periods after September 30, 2011, and before October 1, 2012, subject to additional amounts as provided by Subdivision (3) 8 of this subsection. The city shall contribute amounts equal to 21 percent of the basic hourly earnings of each member employed by the 10 city for all periods after September 30, 2012, subject to 11 additional amounts as provided by Subdivision (3) of this 12 13 subsection. The city council may also authorize the city to make additional contributions to the police retirement system in 14 whatever amount the city council may determine. Contributions by 15 16 the city shall be made each pay period.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
