- 7 (Article 6243e.1, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) Each municipality in which a fire department to which
- 10 this Act applies is located shall appropriate and contribute to the
- 11 fund an amount equal to a percentage [18.05 percent] of the
- 12 compensation of all members during that month as follows:
- 13 (1) 19.05 percent, beginning on the first pay date
- 14 following September 30, 2010, through the pay date immediately
- 15 preceding September 30, 2011;
- 16 (2) 20.05 percent, beginning on the first pay date
- 17 following September 30, 2011, through the pay date immediately
- 18 preceding September 30, 2012;
- 19 <u>(3)</u> 21.05 percent, for 24 pay dates of the
- 20 municipality beginning on the first pay date following September
- 21 <u>30, 2012; and</u>
- 22 (4) 22.05 percent, for all pay dates of the
- 23 municipality that follow the 24 pay dates referenced in Subdivision
- 24 (3) of this subsection.

- 1 (b) Each firefighter shall pay into the fund each month a
- 2 <u>percentage</u> [13.70 percent] of the firefighter's compensation for
- 3 that month as follows:
- 4 (1) 15.70 percent, for the pay dates of the
- 5 municipality following September 30, 2010, through the pay date
- 6 immediately preceding September 30, 2011;
- 7 (2) 16.20 percent, beginning on the first pay date of
- 8 the municipality following September 30, 2011, through the pay date
- 9 immediately preceding September 30, 2012;
- 10 (3) 16.70 percent, beginning on the first pay date of
- 11 the municipality following September 30, 2012, through the pay date
- 12 immediately preceding September 30, 2013;
- 13 (4) 17.20 percent, beginning on the first pay date of
- 14 the municipality following September 30, 2013, through the pay date
- 15 immediately preceding September 30, 2014;
- 16 (5) 17.70 percent, beginning on the first pay date of
- 17 the municipality following September 30, 2014, through the pay date
- 18 immediately preceding September 30, 2015;
- 19 (6) 18.20 percent, beginning on the first pay date of
- 20 the municipality following September 30, 2015, through the pay date
- 21 immediately preceding September 30, 2016; and
- 22 (7) 18.70 percent, for the first pay date of the
- 23 municipality following September 30, 2016, and all subsequent pay
- 24 dates of the municipality.
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
