| 8  | (1) "Military vehicle" includes an unmarked military                |
| 9  | vehicle operated by military personnel conducting an emergency      |
| 10 | preparedness, response, or recovery operation or participating in a |
| 11 | training exercise for an emergency preparedness, response, or       |
| 12 | recovery operation. The term does not include a vehicle operated    |
| 13 | for personal use.   |
| 14 | (2) "Toll[ <del>, "toll</del> ] project" includes a toll road, toll |
| 15 | highway, turnpike, toll bridge, ferry, or similar project, users of |
| 16 | which are required to pay a toll or fare.                           |
| 17 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives         |
| 18 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as   |
| 19 | provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this    |
| 20 | Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  |
| 21 | Act takes effect September 1, 2011.                                 |
