1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to an exemption from the payment of a toll for unmarked
1-11 military vehicles conducting or training for emergency operations.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 362.901, Transportation
1-14 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-15 (d) In this section:

1-16 (1) "Military vehicle" includes an unmarked military
1-17 vehicle operated by military personnel conducting an emergency
1-18 preparedness, response, or recovery operation or participating in a
1-19 training exercise for an emergency preparedness, response, or
1-20 recovery operation. The term does not include a vehicle operated
1-21 for personal use.

1-22 (2) "Toll[~~, "toll~~] project" includes a toll road, toll
1-23 highway, turnpike, toll bridge, ferry, or similar project, users of
1-24 which are required to pay a toll or fare.

1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
