## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the confidentiality of information obtained by a
3	compliance office of an institution of higher education.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 51.971, Education Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsections (e) and (f) and adding Subsection (g) to read
7	as follows:
8	(e) Information is excepted from disclosure under Chapter
9	552, Government Code, if it is collected or produced:
10	<u>(1)</u> in a compliance program investigation <u>and</u>
11	releasing the information [the release of which] would interfere
12	with an ongoing compliance investigation <u>; or</u>
13	(2) by a systemwide compliance office for the purpose
14	of reviewing compliance processes at a component institution of
15	higher education of a university system [is excepted from
16	disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code].
17	(f) Information made confidential or excepted from public
18	disclosure by this section may be made available to the following on
19	request in compliance with applicable law and procedure:
20	(1) a law enforcement agency or prosecutor;
21	(2) a governmental agency responsible for
22	investigating the matter that is the subject of a compliance
23	report, including the Texas Workforce Commission civil rights
24	division or the federal Equal Employment Opportunity Commission; or

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1 (3) an officer or employee of an institution of higher 2 education or a compliance officer or employee of a university 3 system administration who is responsible under institutional or 4 system policy for a compliance program investigation or for 5 reviewing a compliance program investigation [for official 6 purposes of the agency or prosecutor upon proper request made in 7 compliance with applicable law and procedure].

8 (g) A disclosure under Subsection (f) is not a voluntary
9 disclosure for purposes of Section 552.007, Government Code.

10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
