## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the dedication of certain unclaimed state lottery prize money to support education. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 466.408(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) If a claim is not made for prize money on or before the 180th day after the date on which the winner was selected, the prize 8 money shall be used in the following order of priority: 9 subject to legislative appropriation, not more 10 (1)11 than \$20 million in prize money each year may be deposited to or appropriated from the [Texas] Department of State Health Services 12 state-owned multicategorical teaching hospital account, which is 13 14 an account in the general revenue fund; (2) not more than \$5 million in prize money each year 15 may be appropriated to the Health and Human Services Commission and 16 shall be used to support the provision of inpatient hospital 17 services in hospitals located in the 15 counties that comprise the 18 Texas-Mexico border area, with payment for those services to be not 19 20 less than the amount established under the Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act of 1982 (TEFRA) cost reimbursement methodology 21 for the hospital providing the services; 22 23 (3) the remaining amount, not to exceed \$5 million in 24 prize money in each state fiscal year less any amount deposited in

1 the fund in that year attributable to the lottery game operated 2 under Section 466.027, shall be deposited to the fund for veterans' 3 assistance; and

4 (4) all prize money subject to this section and not appropriated in accordance with [from the Texas Department of 5 6 Health state-owned multicategorical teaching hospital account, not appropriated to the Health and Human Services Commission for the 7 8 purpose specified in] Subdivision (1) or (2), and not deposited 9 under Subdivision (3), shall be deposited to the credit of the foundation school fund [in the general revenue fund and may be 10 appropriated for any purpose as determined by the legislature, 11 including the provision of indigent health care services as 12 specified in Chapter 61, Health and Safety Code]. 13 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
