1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the deadline for filing a suit to compel an appraisal
1-9 review board to change an appraisal roll.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (g), Section 25.25, Tax Code, is
1-12 amended to read as follows:

1-13 (g) Within 60 [~~45~~] days after receiving notice of the
1-14 appraisal review board's determination of a motion under this
1-15 section, the property owner or the chief appraiser may file suit to
1-16 compel the board to order a change in the appraisal roll as required
1-17 by this section.

1-18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
1-19 to a suit to compel an appraisal review board to order a change in an
1-20 appraisal roll filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A
1-21 suit to compel an appraisal review board to order a change in an
1-22 appraisal roll filed before the effective date of this Act is
1-23 governed by the law in effect on the date the suit was filed, and the
1-24 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
