## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the issuance of cease and desist orders by the Texas
- 3 Medical Board.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 165.052, Occupations
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) If it appears to the board that a person who is not
- 8 licensed under this subtitle is violating this subtitle, a rule
- 9 adopted under this subtitle, or another state statute or rule
- 10 relating to the practice of medicine, the board [after notice and
- 11 opportunity for a hearing] may issue a cease and desist order
- 12 prohibiting the person from engaging in the activity. Before
- 13 <u>issuing the order, the board must provide the person with the same</u>
- 14 notice and the same opportunity for an informal proceeding and a
- 15 formal hearing as provided to a license holder under Chapter 164.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a hearing for which notice is provided under Section 165.052,
- 18 Occupations Code, on or after the effective date of this  $\mbox{Act.}$  A
- 19 hearing for which notice is provided before the effective date of
- 20 this Act is governed by the law in effect when the notice is
- 21 provided, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 22 purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
