- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 61.227(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) On receipt of a certification of the amount of financial
- 7 need from an approved institution, the coordinating board shall
- 8 certify the amount of the tuition equalization grant based on
- 9 financial need but not to exceed the maximum [a] grant amount, if
- 10 any, [of more than that] specified by legislative [in the]
- 11 appropriation or any other limitation specified by this section [by
- 12 the legislature, or more than the difference between the tuition at
- 13 the private institution attended and the tuition at public colleges
- 14 and universities].
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 16 beginning with tuition equalization grants awarded for the 2011
- 17 fall semester. Grants awarded for a semester or term before the
- 18 2011 fall semester are governed by the law in effect immediately
- 19 before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is
- 20 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
