- Sec. 562.0545. ACCELERATED REFILLS. A pharmacist may
 dispense up to a 90-day supply of a dangerous drug pursuant to a
 valid prescription that specifies dispensation of a lesser amount
 followed by periodic refills of that amount if:
- (1) the total quantity of dosage units dispensed does
 not exceed the total quantity of dosage units authorized by the
 prescriber on the original prescription, including refills;
- 19 <u>(2) the physician has not specified on the</u> 20 prescription that dispensing the prescription in an initial amount
- 21 <u>followed by periodic refills is medically necessary; and</u>
- 22 (3) in the pharmacist's professional judgment,
- 23 dispensing the prescription in this manner would not be harmful to
- 24 the patient.
