- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 375.306(h), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (h) Sections 375.061, <u>375.063</u>, 375.066, and 375.068 and the
- 8 limitations of Section 375.072(c) do not apply to this subchapter.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 375.307(a), Local Government Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), to be qualified to
- 12 <u>serve as a director</u> [a majority of the directors] of an authority, a
- 13 person must:
- 14 (1) reside in the authority; or
- 15 (2) own property in the authority [meet the
- 16 qualifications of Section 375.063].
- 17 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to a director appointed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 A director appointed before the effective date of this Act is
- 20 governed by the law in effect on the date the director was
- 21 appointed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 22 purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
