1-8 relating to reporting to the Texas Judicial Council the election or
1-9 appointment of certain municipal officers.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Chapter 150, Local Government Code, is amended
1-12 by adding Subchapter C to read as follows:

1-13 SUBCHAPTER C. MUNICIPAL REPORTS

1-14 Sec. 150.051. REPORT TO TEXAS JUDICIAL COUNCIL. The
1-15 officer or employee responsible for maintaining the records of the
1-16 governing body of a municipality shall notify the Texas Judicial
1-17 Council of the name of each person who is elected or appointed as
1-18 presiding officer of the municipality, municipal court judge, or
1-19 clerk of a municipal court of the municipality. The officer or
1-20 employee shall notify the judicial council not later than the 30th
1-21 day after the date of the person's election or appointment.

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
