5	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 545.309 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 545.309. IDLING BUS DIESEL ENGINE AT SCHOOL OR IN
8	SCHOOL CROSSING ZONE PROHIBITED. (a) In this section, "idling"
9	means allowing an engine to run while the motor vehicle is not
10	engaged in forward or reverse motion.
11	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the operator of a
12	school bus equipped with a diesel engine may not allow the idling of
13	the bus engine while the bus is parked at a school or in a school
14	crossing zone.
15	(c) Subsection (b) does not prohibit the idling of a school
16	bus diesel engine:
17	(1) for the minimum time necessary to operate the bus
18	before departure, provided that the engine is turned off when a
19	student is embarking or disembarking; or
20	(2) as necessary to accommodate the physical needs of
21	a student who receives special education services, regardless of
22	whether students are embarking or disembarking.
23	(d) A local authority may enforce this section, including on
24	school property.
