4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 209, Property Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 209.014 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 209.014. MANDATORY ELECTIONS IN CERTAIN
8	CIRCUMSTANCES. (a) Notwithstanding any provision in a dedicatory
9	instrument, the board of the property owners' association shall
10	call a special election to elect a new board not later than the 30th
11	day after the date on which the board fails to call a regular
12	meeting of the members of the association as required by a
13	dedicatory instrument.
14	(b) If the board fails to call a special election as
15	required under Subsection (a), an owner may demand that the
16	election be held within a reasonable time. The demand must be made
17	in writing and sent to each board member by certified mail, return
18	receipt requested.
19	(c) If the board fails to call the special election before
20	the 61st day after the date the owner mailed the demand under
21	Subsection (b), an owner may compel the association to hold the
22	special election by initiating legal action against the board

23	members. Each owner has a justiciable interest sufficient to

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1 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a 2 property owners' association created before, on, or after the 3 effective date of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
