- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 151.009, Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Sec. 151.009. "TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY". "Tangible
- 7 personal property" means personal property that can be seen,
- 8 weighed, measured, felt, or touched or that is perceptible to the
- 9 senses in any other manner, and, for the purposes of this <u>title</u>
- 10 [chapter], the term includes a computer program and a telephone
- 11 prepaid calling card.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
