A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the entering of a plea in a criminal case by a defendant
- 3 confined in a penal institution.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 27.19, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, a
- 9 court shall accept a plea of guilty or nolo contendere from a
- 10 defendant who is confined in a penal institution if the plea is
- 11 made:
- 12 (1) in accordance with the procedure established by
- 13 Article 27.18; or
- 14 (2) in writing, including a writing delivered by
- 15 United States mail or secure electronic or facsimile transmission,
- 16 before the appropriate court having jurisdiction in the county in
- 17 which the penal institution is located, provided that:
- 18 (A) the defendant is notified by the court of
- 19 original jurisdiction of the right to counsel and the procedures
- 20 for requesting appointment of counsel, and is provided a reasonable
- 21 opportunity to request a court-appointed lawyer;
- 22 (B) if the defendant elects to proceed without
- 23 counsel, the defendant must waive the right to counsel in
- 24 accordance with Article 1.051;

- 1 (C) the defendant must waive the right to be
- 2 present at the taking of the plea or to have counsel present, if the
- 3 defendant has counsel; and
- 4 (D) if the defendant is charged with a felony,
- 5 judgment and sentence are rendered in accordance with the
- 6 conditions and the procedure established by Article 42.14(b).
- 7 (c) Before accepting a plea submitted under Subsection
- 8 (a)(2), the court shall verify that the person submitting the plea
- 9 is:
- 10 (1) the defendant named in the information or
- 11 indictment; or
- 12 (2) a person with legal authority to act for the
- 13 <u>defendant named in the information or indictment.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. Article 27.19, Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- 15 amended by this Act, applies to a plea of guilty or nolo contendere
- 16 entered on or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of
- 17 whether the offense with reference to which the plea is entered is
- 18 committed before, on, or after that date.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
