BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 51.305(b), Government Code, is amended 5 to read as follows:

7 (b) The commissioners court of a county may adopt a district court records archive fee of not more than \$5 for the filing of a 8 suit, including an appeal from an inferior court, or a 9 10 cross-action, counterclaim, intervention, contempt action, motion for new trial, or third-party petition, in any [a] [district] court 11 12 where the district clerk accepts a filing in the county as part of 13 the county's annual budget. The fee must be set and itemized in the county's budget as part of the budget preparation process and must 14 be approved in a public meeting. The fee is for preservation and 15 restoration services performed in connection with maintaining a 16 17 district court records archive.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
